"Deutscher Krebspreis" – German Cancer Award 2020 for Excellent Clinical Research

The German Cancer Award 2020 for Excellent Clinical Research was awarded on 20 February 2020 to Prof. Dr. h.c. Andreas du Bois.

The German Cancer Award, sponsored by Deutschen Krebsgesellschaft [German Cancer Society] and Deutsche Krebsstiftung [German Cancer Foundation], is one of the highest awards in German cancer medicine. It is awarded once a year for outstanding achievements in experimental, translational and clinical research. In the "Clinical Research" category, the 2020 award went to Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. Andreas du Bois.
